To Whom it May Concern,

At February 3, 2010 meeting of the Eight Streets Neighborhood Association, Felino Sampson, owner and chef of the restaurant Pops, located at 560 Tremont St, Boston, MA, came to the monthly association meeting to ask for our support for extending the restaurant closing time form Midnight to 1am, 7 days a week.

Mr. Sampson is requesting that his liquor license be amended to extend the closing time form Midnight to 1am, 7 days a week. He felt that the extended closing time would better serve his customers. Some ESNA members were in support of the extended closing hour. But many direct abutters complained that many noise issues at the rear of the restaurant had not been adequately addressed. During a previous presentation by Pops to ESNA several months ago, issues of employee smoking, chatter and general restaurant noise at the rear of the restaurant were excessive. Pops bask onto a residential alley where any noise carries into residential homes. At the Feb 3rd meeting, many abutters said their complaints of noise at the rear of the restaurant had gone unresolved, and did not wish to support an extension of hours while said issues remained unresolved. Residents were also concerned that a later closing time meant that clean-up time would also go an hour later, which would be a hardship during weekdays.

The Eight Streets Membership voted to *not support* the extension of closing hours at this time. Pops met with ESNA leadership after the meeting and agreed to work with ESNA to get any outstanding noise issues addressed in the coming months.
